1. Following the new UNRRA policy, it has been decided that, effective 15th May 1947, all Class I and II personnel will be withdrawn from the camps, and replaced by D.P.'s, chosen by mutual agreement between the Committees and the UNRRA Director.
2. Your selection as ... Employment Officer..... (UNRRA - DPAP) has been approved.
3. You are therefore, effective 15th May 1947, responsible for the management of your section, and will have to report all incidents and all problems arising to UNRRA who will be your employer until a successory agency takes over.
4. It must be clearly understood that you will have to carry out instructions and orders received by your employer, who, as you know, is responsible directly to the Occupational Army.
5. In return, UNRRA and the successory agency will grant you all necessary assistance to fulfil your mission.
